Meeting Called to Order

Calendar Updates: Pam reported that not as many calendars have been returned as last year at this time. 1500 Calendars have been printed by the shop at the jail. Catherine in the front office has been making announcements for students to drop the \$\$ and receipts with her. Noted that Baseball/Softball players were supposed to sell 10 per our agreement to fund the dugout project, but most have not done so. January winners will be pulled at the February meeting. Kathy Cairns mentioned, the man at the Charlemont/Shelburne transfer station would be willing to sell the calendars, and we discussed possibly having calendars for sale at other locations.

Redemptions Updates: Kathy Cairns reported that there are still not enough volunteers to help with bottles and cans. She went on New Year's Eve and no one showed up to help. Need to get teams to commit to certain months. Ski team makes it mandatory for the team members. We have made \$50,226 in the past few years, it is a major fundraiser for the MAA.

Update on Booster Gear: Brandon has 100 shirts that are simple and say MAA on them. Now the question is who to give them to. Suggested to give to those volunteers who help with concessions.

Basketball Concessions Update: Jessica and Brian Reid have come forward to help with concessions during girls games. Basketball concessions have been going basically one day at time and a few people have volunteered but no one has come forward to coordinate. Pam reported that some of the kids have been helping with setting up the tables etc. before the games. Due to the old mini fridges being out of order, MAA will purchase a new one for \$159 as voted in the Executive meeting.

Nordic Ski Team: Coach Peter Brayton requested \$945 for 7 new uniforms that are cut for women. He reported that some of his race suits are 10 years old. He also had a large number of kids come out for Nordic Skiing this year. Pam asked him about a coffee fundraiser the Nordic team did at Thanksgiving and Phil reported it was to raise funds for his kids to train at Stowe over Christmas break. They have been doing it for years, previously selling pies, cookie dough and now coffee. We talked about coordinating and getting fundraisers approved, so we can support all of the athletes and not duplicate efforts.

Peter also reported an encounter he had with a dog walker on the school's cross country trails...it was bad enough to call the police.

Open Floor: Brandon reported that Ski Team is selling Mohawk pom pom hats for \$20 to raise money for a trip to a high ropes course in the spring.

Door Prize Drawing: Peter Brayton won a polar fleece hat, Jessica Reid won a lanyard.
